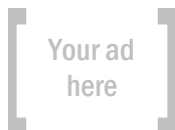
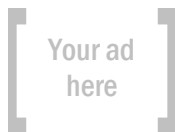

Description:

Green Bay Packaging's Mill Division was built in the 1940s as a 100% virgin corrugating medium mill, which utilized the newly developed NSSC pulping process. As early as 1957 the first recycled fiber was incorporated into the raw material mix, and it increased to 50% in the late 1980s. Between 1989 and 1991, the facility was completely redesigned, rebuilt, and converted to a state-of-the-art 100% recycled linerboard mill.

The current capacity of the Green Bay Mill is 220,000 tons per year. Products include 100% recycled linerboard in basis weights from 26# through 47#/msf, and Eco-Stack™ High Performance Board in 36# and 62#/msf basis weights.

Following the tour, we will continue right down the road to Titledown Brewery for a brief Chapter Meeting and Networking Supper.
