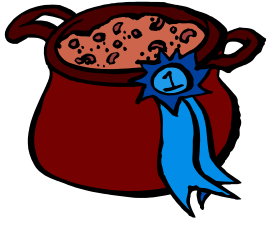

Description: Join us for the 2011 Winter Social! Enter the chili cook-off competition (see rules below), or simply come to feast, network, and submit your People's Choice vote! The event will be hosted at Titledown Brewery, where beverages will be available for purchase. Contestants who bring their chili will be eligible for prizes in the categories of Judge's Choice, People's Choice, and others. The panel of judges will include Steve Padley, Executive Chef at Birds Eye Foods.

Chili Cook-off Rules:

1. Chili must be cooked in advance, from raw ingredients, and brought ready to serve by 4:45pm.
2. We do not specify/restrict ingredients for this event. Chili may consist of any kind of meat, beans, vegetables or combinations thereof, cooked with peppers, spices, and other ingredients. All meats must be cooked thoroughly.
3. Commercial chili powder is permissible, but complete commercial chili mixes are not permitted.
4. A complete listing of ingredients must be displayed. Quantities do not need to be included.
5. Contestants must give their chili a name.
6. Contestants must provide their own heating apparatus (crock pot, electric roaster, etc) to maintain the temperature of the chili (140 degrees or higher), as well as extension cords and cooking utensils.
7. Contestants should bring a minimum of 2 gallons of chili.
8. Contestants must be willing to eat their own chili.
9. Judging will be based on a ranking system in the following categories: color, consistency, aroma, taste, and aftertaste (the burn!).
10. Serving cups, spoons, and napkins will be provided by the organizers.
11. Voting will end at 6:30pm.
