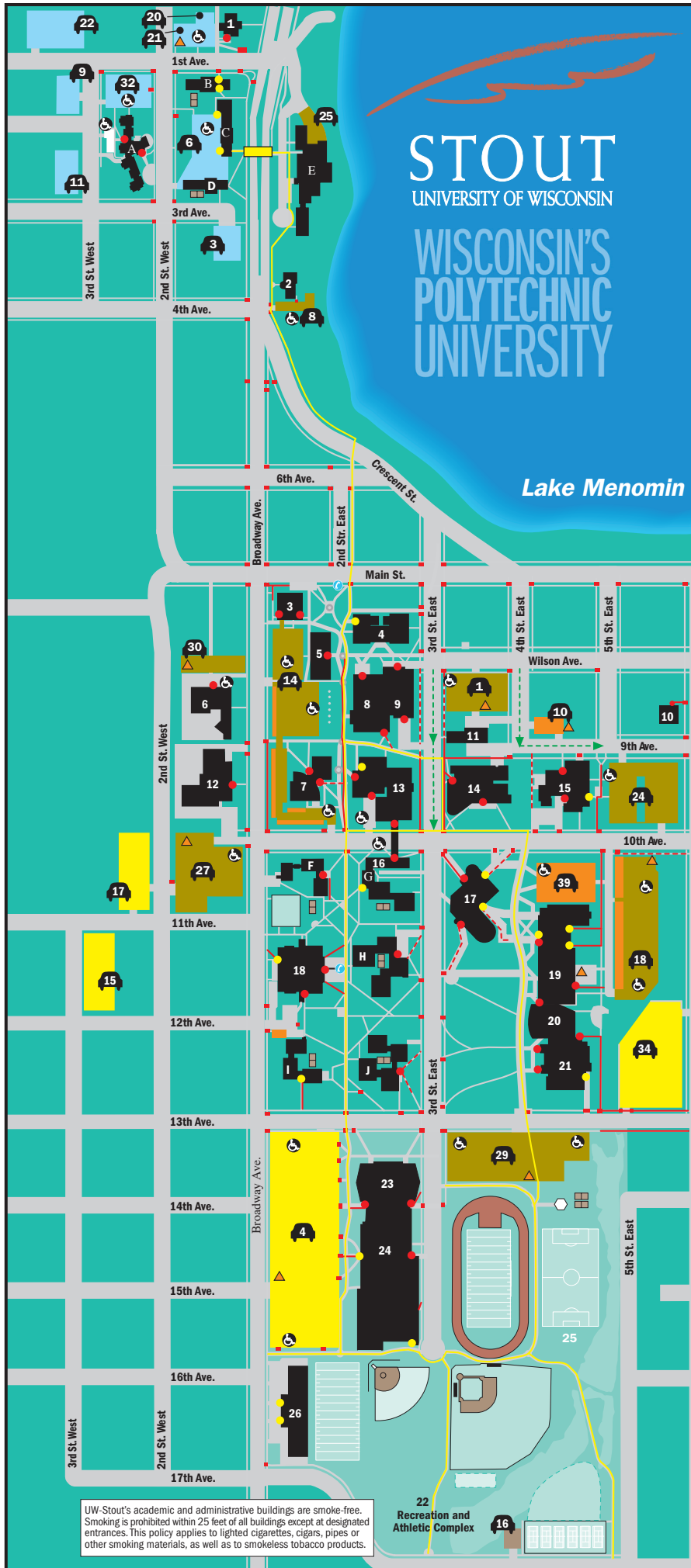

Resident Student Lots

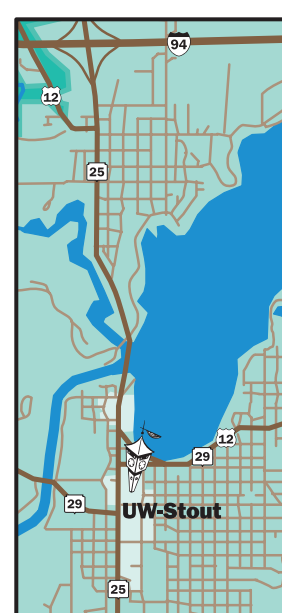
Regulated 24 hrs/day; between 9 p.m. Sunday and 1 p.m. Friday
